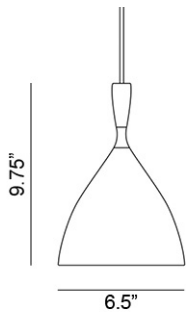

If Mad Men decided to take its mid-century modern pizzazz on the road into the glacial climes of Norway, this pendant light would serve its style-consciousness well. The precursor to the Dokka pendant was the first Norwegian light to ever be awarded the Golden Medal at the Milan Triennale. Designed by Birger Dahl, the post-war icon debuted in 1954 but it has never lost its fresh appeal, available in dark green, light yellow, rust, black, dark gray and white.
